- Understand the effect of coagulation disorders on labour analgesia management and discuss suitable alternative strategies including intravenous opioids and nitrous oxide;
- Identify women at risk for postpartum haemorrhage and quantify haemorrhage using all available information;
- Devise and implement management plans for maternal critical condition within the available setting including massive transfusion;
- Debate optimal delivery anaesthesia for the unstable critically ill pregnant woman;
- Incorporate crisis resource management tools in decision making in critically ill pregnant women.
